- Present a concept paper to the CBP Integrated Monitoring Networks Workgroup (August, 2017), the Data Integrity Workgroup (August) and then STAR (September)
- Consult with Carin Bisland and Kristin Saunders to develop a strategy to effectively navigate the CBP management structure to get the necessary level of support (September)
- Present the concept paper to the CBP GIT coordinators and staffers to continue its development, review and approval ((October-December)
- Brief the Partnership's advisory committees (Fall/winter quarterly meetings)
- Meet with CBP signatories to discuss the MOU and identify concerns and refine the MOU (December 2017-Janury 2018)
- Get on the agenda for the Management Board (February 2018)
- Present the draft MOU and larger context and importance to the Partnership to the Principals' Staff Committee and seek approval and adoption(Spring 2018)
