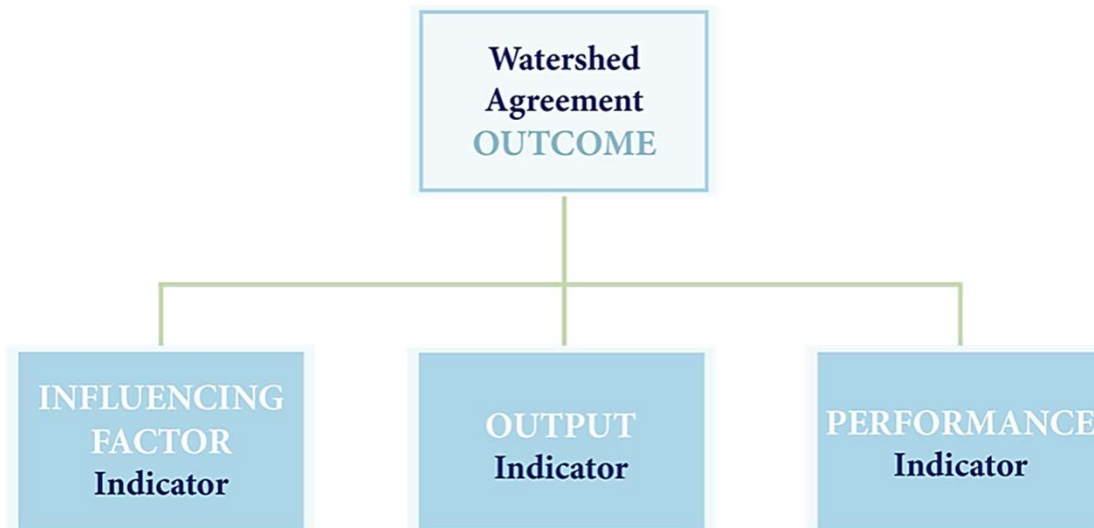

- Used to meet monitoring or tracking needs related to adaptive management or tracking progress toward the Watershed Agreement identified by GITs

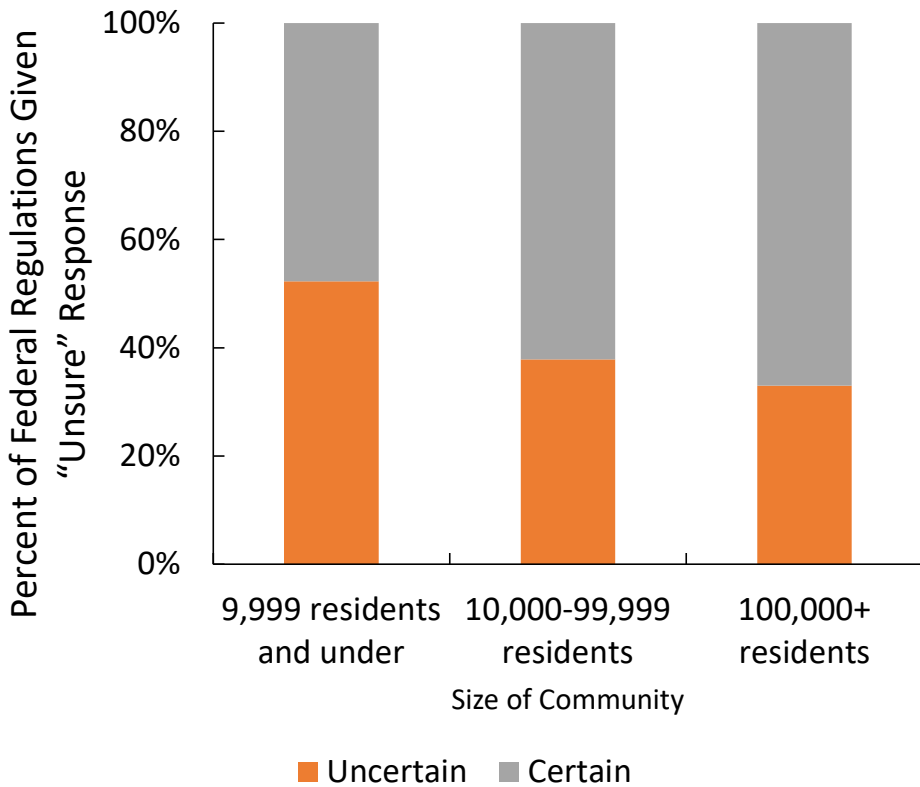


Indicators and Local Leadership Workgroup

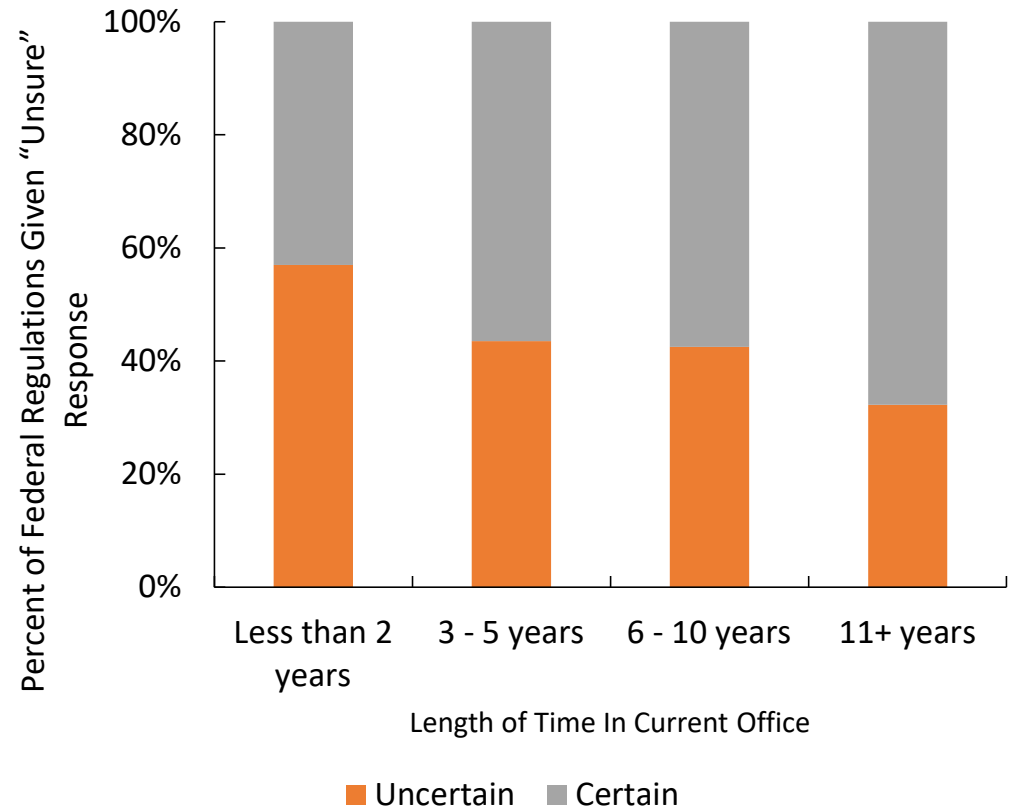
- Provides measurable data for the LLWG outcome to track progress and changes over time
