  reduction <u>and</u> biological uplift
- Reinforce the key qualifying conditions for stream restoration projects involved in TMDL implementation;
- Opportunities to provide incentives or other mechanisms for functional lift as part of TMDL credited projects
- Identify some of the emerging (and latent/persistent) permit issues that regulators should consider when reviewing these projects
- Discuss how stream restoration projects should be inspected/verified after permit conditions expire

- No focus on several MD-specific issues like the IC treatment equivalency and SHA design build RFP, which are the appropriate purview of MDE/DNR.
