

"Continually improve the capacity to monitor and assess the effects of management actions being undertaken to implement the Chesapeake Bay Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) and improve water quality. Use the monitoring results to report annually to the public on progress made in attaining established Bay water-quality standards and trends in reducing nutrients and sediment in the watershed."

Eligible Projects Support one or more related Outcomes

Not intended to support long-term implementation or restoration

Implementation of a pilot project is acceptable

Improve or expand upon past projects and can have phased projects

Must be unique and not duplicative
