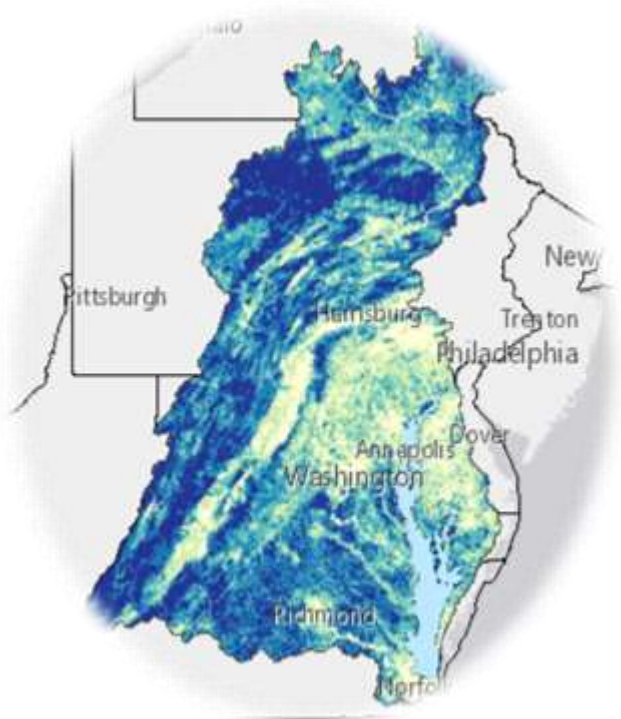


How healthy is your watershed?



The Chesapeake Bay Program's Maintain Healthy Watersheds Goal Implementation Team is excited to announce the publication of the [Chesapeake Healthy Watersheds Assessment](#), an online, geospatial tool that summarizes the different landscape and water conditions in catchments across the entire watershed.

It was designed to help support and inform land use decisions that prioritize infrastructure resiliency, public health, and education while also protecting the environment in your community.

Modeled after EPA's Preliminary Healthy Watersheds Assessment, the health metrics can be summarized into an overall watershed health index and include data related to:



Landscape Condition



Habitat



Hydrology



Water Quality



Geomorphology
