#### 11:05 am New Chair nomination - Jeff Lerner, Healthy Watersheds Consortium Grant Consortium

Jeff is currently a consultant to the U.S. Endowment for Forestry and Communities managing the Healthy Watersheds Consortium Grant Program, a national partnership with EPA and NRCS aimed at accelerating the protection of watersheds in good condition since 2015. The program has supported several watershed protection efforts in the Chesapeake Bay and EPA Region 3. He has also managed projects in the Chesapeake Bay including a strategy for marsh migration and sea level rise around Blackwater NWR and green infrastructure planning to build resilience in central Maryland as part of the Greater Baltimore Wilderness Coalition (GBWC). Previous experience includes working with The Nature Conservancy, The Conservation Fund, Defenders of Wildlife, and the Doris Duke Charitable Foundation. Much of this work has been in partnership with federal, state, and local agencies focused on proactive and strategic conservation. Jeff still serves on the Steering Committee for GBWC and for the past several years he has participated in the Healthy Watersheds GIT meetings.

The Maintain Healthy Watersheds GIT has been working proactively to determine the best way to communicate the work of the goal team to CBP partners, cross goal teams, stakeholders and to general interests. John has been working behind the scenes to compile and present the umbrella of resources developed through the years by our GIT. Using ESRI Stroymaps and additional visualization tools, a comprehensive set of storymaps has been compiled that not only describe the history and importance of our goal team, our work, and the adaptive management framework, but also embeds the Chesapeake Healthy Watershed Assessment, cross outcome coordination, and emerging climate, DEIJ and administration priorities. In addition, John will reveal some protypes for displaying and visualizing Interim healthy watersheds outcome indicators that are part of the story maps, including development pressure, protected lands, brook trout, and DEIJ.
