

QPM Overview

Duration	Topic	Description
45 min	Outcome Review	Comprises of a presentation, discussion and wrap up for each Outcome.
15 min	 Presentation 	The Outcome Lead presents the findings, challenges, and any requests for assistance.
15 min	• Discussion	The Management Board provides perspectives, ask clarifying questions, and consider responses to the requests for assistance.
15 min	Wrap Up	The Management Board agrees upon action items and next steps.
15 min	Alignment of Outcome Requests	Follows the presentation of all Outcomes for a discussion period to align Outcome requests, address parking lot items and overarching perspectives for the cohort regarding Outcome attainability.

QPM Overview – Next Gen Stewards

Duration	Topic	Description
20 min	Cohort Summary: Next Generation Stewards	Summary presentation, concluding with the four general asks – what is needed
30 min	Outcome Review #1: Student	 Each review is comprised of a: 15-minute presentation, includes an awareness of what do we want you to know and ends with a discussion question 15-minute input from the MB and DOE Reps on the discussion question – through open discussion and via Jamboard
30 min	Outcome Review #2: Sustainability Schools	
30 min	Outcome Review #3: Environmental Literacy	
30 min	Wrap Up of Cohort & Alignment of Outcome Requests	MB and State DOE Reps respond to the four specific asks/help needed

QPM Ground Rules for Discussion & Wrap Up
