Biennial SRS Meeting Next Steps

The Partnership held its 2021 Biennial Strategy Review System (SRS) meeting on May 12-13. A recap and synthesis of the discussions was presented.

- Action: The SRS Planning Team will take feedback gathered at the Biennial Meeting and the June Management Board (MB) meeting and develop a set of recommended changes to the CBP Governance Document, the SRS process and materials for implementation in the third cycle of the SRS.

Review and acceptance of final Quarterly Progress Meeting materials for the following outcomes: Climate Adaptation, Climate Monitoring and Assessment, Local Leadership and Tree Canopy

The final materials for the Local Action Cohort QPM and the two climate outcomes were presented as final.

- Action: The MB accepted as final the materials for the following outcomes:
 - Climate Adaptation
 - Climate Monitoring and Assessment
 - Local Leadership
 - Tree Canopy
- Action from the February MB Meeting: The MB will be prepared to help identify and discuss resource solutions that can support a path forward for both the climate resiliency outcomes at the July 15, 2021 MB meeting.

Chesapeake Bay Program Youth Initiative

A cohort of 10-15 students, called Youth Ambassadors, are being selected to participate in a 5 month-long program, working alongside mentors from the Chesapeake Bay Program to develop an understanding of the complex issues facing the Chesapeake Bay Watershed. The Initiative will culminate in a final presentation to the MB in fall of 2021.

- Decision: The MB agreed to reserve *up to* two hours on the October MB agenda (agenda availability pending) to allow the participants in the CBP Youth Initiative to present and ask questions of MB members.
- Action: MB members are encouraged to engage with the students and provide mentorship opportunities if possible. Several MB members volunteered to work with the students including: Michelle Price-Fay (Acting Chair), Ann Swanson (CBC), Ann Jennings (Va.), Katherine
