FY2020 GIT Funding Allocation Process



Process Essentials

- All GIT Priority 1 projects will be funded
- All remaining projects that have been submitted will be evaluated and scored by the GITs (one score per GIT)
- Projects will be ranked by average score and projects will be funded based on score until funds are depleted

Assumptions

- GIT 5 will establish a single Priority 1; the remaining GIT 5 projects will be included in the pool of projects to be scored
- Each GIT will provide a single score for each proposal, taking input from coordinators, staffers and other GIT members as appropriate
- Priority 1 projects will be evaluated (GIT self-eval or whole group TBD)
