

## Enhance Partnering, Leadership and Management Goal Implementation Team Membership Definition

The Enhance Partnering, Leadership and Management Goal Implementation Team (GIT 6) and its respective workgroups strive to maintain a membership that is representative of the signatories to the 2014 Chesapeake Bay Watershed Agreement and othersthose that take leadership roles in the Chesapeake Bay Program structure, while non-signatories. - Chair of each GIT 6 Workgroup and the Communications Workgroup (3)

- One advisor from the Scientific and Technical Advisory Committee and each GIT Workgroup plus Communications Workgroup (invited) (4)
