- 1) Overall: PCBs, PAHs, and mercury are listed together several times. Be consistent in the order in which they are listed and in the order in which they are discussed unless there is a reason to deviate. Done
- 2) 1st page, 2nd paragraph: PAHs are not defined until the second paragraph but are first introduced in 1st paragraph. Done
- 1st page: Suggest keeping the agricultural sections together and the urban sections together. The flow of the paragraphs seems jumbled. Rearranged to keep sectors together
- 4) 1st page, 4th paragraph: use UTCs as abbreviation after first mention in 2nd paragraph. Done
- 5) 2nd page: What is the top asterisk associated with? Assume that it is with something on the first page, but it is unclear what it refers to. Asterisk has been linked to table title
- 6) 2nd page, Tools and Resources: These are inconsistent with how they are listed and used on other factsheets. Will continue to work to reconcile with other fact sheets as needed
