Toxic Contaminants

USACE

- 1) Overall: PCBs, PAHs, and mercury are listed together several times. Be consistent in the order in which they are listed and in the order in which they are discussed unless there is a reason to deviate. **Done**
- 2) 1st page, 2nd paragraph: PAHs are not defined until the second paragraph but are first introduced in 1st paragraph. **Done**
- 3) 1st page: Suggest keeping the agricultural sections together and the urban sections together. The flow of the paragraphs seems jumbled. **Rearranged to keep sectors together**
- 4) 1st page, 4th paragraph: use UTCs as abbreviation after first mention in 2nd paragraph. **Done**
- 5) 2nd page: What is the top asterisk associated with? Assume that it is with something on the first page, but it is unclear what it refers to. **Asterisk has been linked to table title**
- 6) 2nd page, Tools and Resources: These are inconsistent with how they are listed and used on other factsheets. **Will continue to work to reconcile with other fact sheets as needed**
