**Interactive Map** - This interactive map has additional layers that are not included in the story map. These include property boundaries and protected lands in addition to the state green infrastructure and nature's network layers that are available on both maps. The property layers do not have landowner information (which I removed for privacy reasons), but in most cases they do have parcel and map numbers. To access this information for a given parcel, you just right click on it. When you first open the map, you may need to click on "Contents" to see all of the layers. To add a layer to the map, just click on the box to the left of it. With slow internet like mine it can take awhile for the layers to load. I think this map as is can be used for planning, so I'm going to use it for my targeting purposes while we continue to forge forward with drafting the Strategic Action Plan.
