The MB is recommending to the PSC a lengthen the development schedule that will add two years to the development timeline and allow all partnership teams and workgroups to do a more thorough job addressing partnership suggestions for improving modeling tools and that will also allow for the evaluation of 2025 progress to be completed before focusing on the application of the Phase 7 suite of models.
