Draft Changes (8/8/18 Version—V3)

- **New Factor Influencing Success:** The extent of collaboration and coordination among the science and management communities at a scale that is commensurate with the extent of PCB impairments and TMDLs
- **New Management Approach:** PCB Consortium
- Lessons learned from all GIT projects (next slide)
- Inclusion of other contaminants (PAHs)
- 4 areas of focus to Science Management Approach:
 - Identify Sources
 - BMP Effectiveness
 - Status and Change of Environmental Conditions
 - Synthesize and Communicate Results

 - PCB Impairments
 - TMDL status and management/implementation actions
