Nontidal Wetlands Barrier

- Financial constraints
 - New infrastructure bill
 - State and NGO match
 - New programs
- Other funding sources
 - Build Back Better
 - Farm Bill
 - State and private funding

Tidal Wetlands Barriers

- Financial constraints- Same as nontidal wetlands as described in the previous slide.
- Technical constraints
 - Understanding rate of tidal wetland loss due to sea level rise
 - Methods for restoration not well established
 - Capacity- few experts in the region, country, world
