

July 9, 2020 Actions/Decisions

SRS Wrap-Up and Follow-Up Actions

- Action: By mid-to -late August 2020, the Education Workgroup will provide Management Board (MB) members with a description of the meeting Maryland recently hosted on environmental education teacher training. Jurisdiction MB members will work with their education counterparts to use Maryland's guidance and, if they so choose, hold similar teacher training meetings in their jurisdictions.
- Action: To address the barriers schools face when using public lands, MB members committed to convene jurisdiction meetings with the parks/natural resource contacts and education leadership contacts they identified to facilitate and increase the use of public lands for environmental literacy instruction by schools. These meetings will be an initial step towards sharing best practices and successes among jurisdictions; identifying solutions including potential changes to funding streams, policies, programs; and setting targets for implementation as part of the 2-year action plans, with accountability identified among multiple CBP partners. The meetings should be scheduled within the next six months. The Education Workgroup recommends scheduling the meetings during the summer, since teachers are currently planning for the 2020-21 school year.
- <u>Action</u>: During the meetings mentioned above, Shannon Sprague (NOAA), Education Workgroup
 Co-Chair, will work with MB members to address any remaining gaps in the Education
 Workgroup's funding sources inventory.

CAST-2019

- <u>Decision</u>: The MB approved CAST-2019. To approve CAST-2019, the MB members registered the following support:

- Action: The MB highlighted the importance of a clear CAST-2019 communications plan that can be tailored to each jurisdiction. Within the communications packet, MB members recommended a section describing the issues of concern raised with development of CAST-2019 and what the plan of action is to resolve those concerns in CAST-2021. MB members may submit suggestions on the communications package to Rachel Felver at rfelver@chesapeakebay.net.
- Action: CBPO staff committed to providing a timeline, commitments and key contacts as the partnership moves towards CAST-2021. The forthcoming materials will have details about the

specific issue, who will lead the effort, which workgroup will be the primary reviewer, and a timeline for completion. A draft will be shared with WQGIT and appropriate workgroups in time for the July 27 WQGIT meeting for their consideration and input. The WQGIT will finalize the materials during their August meeting. The final CAST21 workplan will be discussed by the MB during their September meeting with updates at future MB meetings on a quarterly or bimonthly basis through September 2021
